SUBJECT: EXECUTION OF SPANISH ANARCHIST AND POLISH SEAMAN

REF: MADRID 1414

1. SUMMARY: FOLLOWING CABINET DECISION MARCH 1, BARCELONA ANARCHIST SALVADOR PUIG ANTICH AND POLISH SEAMAN, HEINZ CHEZ, WERE EXECUTED MARCH 2 FOR KILLING OF TWO POLICEMEN. EXERCISING HIS PREROGATIVE OF PARDON, FRANCO COMMUTED DEATH SENTENCE FOR ANTONIO FRANCO MARTIN, A CIVIL GUARD MEMBER WHO KILLED A CIVIL GUARD CAPTAIN IN 1973. MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND TOURISM TOLD PRESS, WHEN ASKED ABOUT POSSIBLE ADVERSE FOREIGN REACTION THAT GOS COULD NOT BE INFLUENCED BY ANY FOREIGN VIEWS IN CARRYING OUT DOMESTIC JUSTICE. IN REPORTING DETAILS AND BACKGROUND OF CRIMES, SPANISH PRESS REPORTED ATTACKS AGAINST SPANISH EMBASSIES OR FIRMS IN ROME, PARIS AND BRUSSELS.

THERE HAVE BEEN SMALL DEMONSTRATIONS IN BARCELONA WHICH WERE QUICKLY DISPERSED BY POLICE AND TWO REPORTED BOMB

INCIDENTS. CABINET ALSO DECIDED TO OBLIGE ALL IMANISH

BANKS TO UPGRADE SECURITY MEASURES IN WAKE OF AN UNUSUAL INCIDENCE OF BANK ROBBERIES. ON DAY OF EXECUTION MINISTER OF INTERIOR AND VICE PRESIDENT, GARCIA HERNANDEZ, AT CEREMONY HONORING POLICE VICTIM IN PRESIDENT CARRERO BLANCO'S ASSINATION, PLEDGED THAT MARTYRDOM IN DEFENSE OF PUBLIC ORDER WOULD NOT BE IN VAIN AND THAT GOS WOULD ENSURE INTERNAL PEACE "AT ANY COST". END SUMMARY.

2. REGULAR WEEKLY COUNCIL OF MINISTERS MEETING MARCH 1 DECIDED TO CARRY OUT DEATH SENTENCES IN THREE OUTSTANDING CASES: (1) PUIG ANTICH FOR HAVING KILLED A POLICEMAN IN SEPTEMBER 1973; (2) HEINZ CHEZ, A POLISH NATIONAL WHO WAS SENTENCED IN SEPTEMBER 1973 FOR KILLING OF A CIVIL GUARD OFFICER IN DECEMBER 1972; (3) AND ANTONIO FRANCO MARTIN, A CIVIL GUARD MEMBER, WHO WAS CONDEMNED IN JANUARY 1974 FOR KILLING OF A CIVIL GUARD CAPTAIN IN OCTOBER 1973. IN ACCORDANCE WITH MILITARY CODE OF JUSTICE, PUIG AND CHEZ WERE EXECUTED WITHIN 12 HOURS OF CABINET NOTIFICATION ON MORNING OF MARCH 2. EXERCISING HIS PREROGATIVE OF PARDON, CHIEF OF STATE FRANCO ISSUED DECREE MARCH 2 COMMUTING FRANCO MARTIN'S DEATH SENTENCE. BOTH PUIG AND CHEZ WERE EXECUTED BY GARROTE, RESPECTIVELY IN BARCELONA AND TARRAGONA. PUBLIC SECURITY FORCES, SOME ARMED WITH MACHINE GUNS, WERE MUCH IN EVIDENCE IN BARCELONA AND MADRID. US CONGEN REPORTED THAT SOME DEMONSTRATORS HAD GATHERED IN VARIOUS PLACES IN BARCELONA, BUT WERE PROMPTLY DISPERSED BY POLICE. THESE WERE FIRST EXECUTIONS IN SPAIN SINCE JANUARY 2, 1972, WHEN SOLDIR, WHO HAD KILLED A STOREKEEPER AND HIS DAUGHTER, WAS KILLED BY FIRING SQUAD. LAST USE OF GARROTE WAS IN 1966 IN EXECUTION OF MURDERER OF SERGEANT IN CIVIL GUARD.

3. MINISTER OF INFORMATION AND TOURISM, PIO CABANILLAS, HELD LATE EVENING PRESS CONFERENCE MARCH 1, AND, PRESUMABLY IN RESPONSE TO RUMORS ABOUT DISAGREEMENT IN COUNCIL OF MINISTERS, SAID THAT DECISIONS REACHED IN CABINET MEETING WERE CONSIDERED AS COLLECTIVE DECISIONS. IN RESPONSE TO QUESTION FROM FOREIGN CORRESPONDENT ABOUT POSSIBILITY OF ADVERSE FOREIGN REACTION TO EXECUTIONS, CABONILLAS SAID THAT GOS COULD NOT ALLOW ITSELF TO BE INFLUENCED IN ANY WAY BY FOREIGN CONSIDERATIONS IN CARRYING OUT INTERNAL JUSTICE. ACCORDING TO PRESS, POLISH SEAMAN, ALTHOUGH PROVIDED DEFENSE BY GOS, RECEIVED NO SUPPORT OR COMFORT FROM HIS HOMETLAND.

4. LOCAL PRESS MARCH 3 AND 4 REPORTED THAT FIVE INCENDIARY BOMBS HAD BEEN THROWN AGAINST SPANISH EMBASSY IN ROME MARCH 2. SPANISH WORKERS REPORTEDLY ATTACKED SPANISH EMBASSY IN LUXEMBOURG AND ASSAULTED SEVERAL MEMBERS OF THE STAFF. 200 PEOPLE REPORTEDLY IN DEMONSTRATIONS AGAINST SPANISH EMBASSY

IN BRUSSELS WHERE THREE SUBSIDIARIES OF BANCO ESPANOL WERE
ATTACKED WITH INFLAMMABLE MATERIALS. SPECIAL SECURITY
MEASURES HAVE BEEN REPORTEDLY TAKEN TO PROTECT SPANISH
EMBASSY IN PARIS AND BRUSSELS. FRG POLITICAL COUNSELOR TOLD
EMBASSY OFFICER HE HAD RECOMMENDED PROTECTIVE MEASURES FOR
SPANISH INSTALLATIONS IN GERMANY. ACCORDING TO LOCAL
PRESS, MARCH 4, A POWERFUL EXPLOSION TOOK PLACE DURING
NIGHT OF MARCH 3 AGAINST THE ARTILLERY BARRACKS LOCATED AT
SAN ANDRES IN BARCELONA. THERE WERE NO INJURIES. ACCORDING
TO LEADING LAWYER, NATIONAL BAR ASSOCIATION WILL STUDY
PROPOSAL BY BARCELONA AFFILIATE TO APPOINT SPECIAL COMMISSION
TO INVESTIGATE CONSEQUENCES OF GOVERNMENT'S DECISION.

5. CABINET ALSO DECIDED MARCH 1 TO OBLIGE ALL BANKS TO APPOINT
SECURITY OFFICER, EMPLOY ARMED GUARDS, TO INSTALL SIGNALS
LINKED WITH POLICE PRECINCTS, ETC. ACCORDING TO AVAILABLE
STATISTICS, THERE WERE 87 BANK ROBBERIES IN SPAIN IN 1973,
THE LARGEST NUMBER IN HISTORY AND THEY HAVE ALREADY INCREASED
IN NUMBER IN 1974. PUIG ANTICH WAS INVOLVED IN ONE OF

THESE ROBBERIES. (THREE MEN ROBBED A BANK OF \$53,000, LEAVING BEHIND A TIME-BOMB, ON THE DAY OF THE CABINET'S DECISION TO EXECUTE PUIG.)

6. ON DAY OF EXECUTIONS, MARCH 2, MINISTER OF INTERIOR AND VICE PRESIDENT, GARCIA HERNANDEZ, OFFICIATED AT CEREMONY HONORING POLICE INSPECTOR WHO WAS KILLED IN ASSASSINATION OF CARRERO BLANCO, DEC 20, 1973. IN PRESENCE OF DIRECTOR GENERAL OF SECURITY

AND DEPUTY HEAD OF CIVIL GUARD, MINISTER, IN REFERRING TO DEATH OF POLICE OFFICERS, SAID THE "THE EXAMPLE OF THESE MARYTRS OF THE DEFENSE OF ORDER AND PEACE WOULD NOT BE IN VAIN."

HE WENT ON TO AFFIRM THAT GOS WOULD PRESERVE PEACE AND ORDER "AT ANY COST".

7. COMMENT: NEW ARIAS NAVARRO GOVERNMENT HAS BEEN DECISIVE IN DEMONSTRATING ITS WILL TO PRESERVE LAW AND ORDER. ALTHOUGH SUBJECTED TO DOMESTIC AND SOME EXTERNAL PRESSURE, IN FORM OF DEMARCHES BY DUTCH, BELGIANS, ITALIANS AND COMMON MARKET, AND APPEALS BY SPANISH SOCIALIST TO FRG CHANCELLOR FOR INTERVENTION, GOVT DECIDED TO PROCEED WITH EXECUTIONS AS DEMANDED BY MILITARY TRIBUNALS, ALL THREE DEATH SENTENCES, INCLUDING THE COMMUTED ONE, INVOLVED THE KILLING OF EITHER CIVIL GUARD OR POLICE OFFICIALS. NEW MINISTER OF INTERIOR, JUDGING BY HIS REMARKS MARCH 2, OBVIOUSLY DOES NOT INTEND TO JEOPARDIZE NEW GOVERNMENT'S RELATIONS WITH CIVIL GUARD BY LENIENCY IN CASES INVOLVING KILLING OF CIVIL GUARD MEMBERS.

8. BY LINKING EXECUTION OF PUIG WITH NEED TO STRENGTHEN SECURITY OF BANKS AGAINST WAVE OF ROBBERIES, GOS HAS MADE OBVIOUS APPEAL TO POPULATIONS INCLINATION TO SUPPORT ALMOST ANYTHING WHICH WOULD PRESERVE PUBLIC ORDER. PUIG'S INVOLVEMENT WITH ANARCHIST IBERIAN LIBERATION MOVEMENT (MIL) HAS NOT BEEN HIGHLIGHTED. GOS PRESUMABLY HOPES TO PROJECT SENTENCE AND EXECUTION IN LIGHT OF NON-POLITICAL CIVIL CRIME. IMPORTANT OBJECTIVE OF GOVERNMENT IS PREVENTION OF BANK ROBBERIES BY POLITICAL GROUPS SUCH AS MIL AND BASQUE LIBERATION MOVEMENT (ETA). MANY OF BANK ROBBERIES IN PAST YEAR HAVE BEEN CARRIED OUT FOR PURPOSE OF OBTAINING FUNDS TO FINANCE THESE EXTREMIST GROUPS.
